PRESENCE	Participation in 70% of the lessons is set as a condition. Only the active practice counts for presence. In case of absence from more than 30% of the total number of lessons the credits of the course cannot be obtained. Max. 4 lessons absence is allowed.
SCHEDULE OF HANDING IN	The submission of mid-term presentations may be delayed due to the dates in "Topic schedule", but in case of a repeated, or delayed presentation, submission, the value of the project is reduced by one mark! There is no reduction in case of the final submission!
MIN. REQUIREMENT OF ACCOMPLISHMENT	Accomplishment of all mid-term submissions with at least a pass level. On time submission and accomplishment of the final project with at least pass level. By the deadline due to the timetable the final project must be submitted – irrespectively of its readiness. In case of missing the final, delayed submission deadline the credits of the subject cannot be obtained!
